OPCC is a community-supported organization in which staff, volunteers and clients work together with mutual respect to address the effects of poverty, abuse, neglect and discrimination.

OPCC believes in the inherent worth and dignity of each individual. The agency's programs are designed to empower people to rebuild their lives by providing a wide range of practical resources and a continuum of care for men, women and children who need assistance returning to lives of self-sufficiency.

Established in 1963, OPCC is a non-profit, tax-exempt social service agency. Programs are funded in part by the City of Santa Monica, the County of Los Angeles, the State of California, the federal government and numerous private donations from concerned individuals, civic organizations, local businesses, foundations and faith congregations.

OPCC provides services to people in need without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sexual orientation or disability.

Dear Friends,

As we reflect on our work at OPCC, we ask ourselves, *What impact are we having? How are we using our precious resources, both human and financial, to make a difference in the lives of those we serve and in the larger community?* Making a difference is important. It affirms that we're fulfilling our mission and being good stewards of that which has been entrusted to us. Assisting homeless individuals and families leave the streets and find housing is a primary goal of our homeless programs. The impact is tangible in many ways. They have a home and can return to lives of independence and self-sufficiency in a stable living environment with income. The impact in the community: fewer people living on our streets, using less emergency services – police, paramedics and hospital emergency rooms.

Sometimes our impact is less tangible or visible. The woman who calls our domestic violence hotline looking for assistance may not leave her batterer immediately and may never be visible to the larger community. The family who comes to our mental health center for therapy goes about their daily lives without anyone knowing that the changes they are making are having a profound impact for them. The impact of OPCC's work touches lives every day, some very visible and dramatic, and some impacts hidden and subtle.

We are close to finishing the largest capital campaign in our agency's 45-year history. With the opening of both the Cloverfield Services Center and the OPCC Annenberg Access Center, we will impact many more lives by providing access to housing and supportive services. The expanded capacity supports our efforts to reduce street homelessness, which is good for the people we house and for the larger community. Every day our dedicated staff and volunteers work together with those we serve to make a positive impact on individual lives and in the communities where our programs are located. One day, one life at a time, OPCC makes a difference.

On behalf of our entire organization, thank you for your support. Please continue to join us in impacting lives and communities by empowering people to rebuild their lives.

Program Impacts:

- Provided a ‘lifeline’ of critical services to 2,768 homeless and low-income individuals including 133 families (385 family members with children)
- Made 3,022 outreach contacts on the streets, beaches and parks and provided intensive outreach to 315 homeless individuals
- Distributed 959 bags of groceries to low-income, housed individuals and families
- Placed 350 individuals and families in temporary housing and provided 60 permanent housing placements
- Prepared and distributed 50,448 sack lunches
- 310 volunteers provided 4,746 hours of service

Services Include:

- Food, clothing, showers, restrooms, transportation, mail and message services, access to housing and job referrals
- Medical and mental health care, crisis intervention and case management
- Outreach teams working in the parks and on the streets of Santa Monica contact homeless individuals and families, provide referral and transportation to services; teams also respond to local businesses and community members requesting intervention with homeless persons
- Specialized case management services to homeless families

Campion Empowering people experiencing trauma, including vulnerable battered women, abused children and homeless individuals and families, to rebuild their lives by receiving high quality mental health services.

Program Impacts:

- Provided mental health counseling to 674 individuals including 120 children
- Conducted 4,117 individual counseling sessions
- Provided training and internships to 14 marriage / family therapy and social work interns

Services Include:

- Crisis intervention, support groups and short and longer-term therapy for all OPCC clients
- School-based counseling for at-risk children and adolescents
- Training and supervision for graduate school and post-graduate interns, generating well-trained, experienced mental health professionals who have an increased understanding of those suffering from trauma, severe and persistent mental illness and homelessness
- Working closely with and providing training seminars for mental health providers throughout the community

Daybreak Empowering mentally ill homeless women to rebuild their lives through a complete continuum of care, from a drop-in center to permanent housing with ongoing support.

Program Impacts:

- Provided a ‘lifeline’ of basic survival services to 537 women
- Housed 49 women in Daybreak Shelter and sheltered 71 women in Daybreak’s new emergency beds
- Placed 47 women in permanent housing
- Enabled 74 women to obtain employment
- Provided supportive services to 133 WIND participants
- 213 volunteers provided 2,346 hours of service

Services Include:

- Day Center provides basic emergency services for mentally ill homeless women, including food, shelter, clothing, showers, case management, health care
- Structured group living preparing residents for self-sufficiency offers special activities, budgeting, self-care assistance, job readiness skills, psychiatric and medical care
- Women in New Directions (WIND), a vital extension for current and former clients, provides a client-motivated continuum of care for women who moved into permanent housing, with classes in life skills, arts and crafts, social and recreational activities
- The client-run business, Daybreak Designs, is comprised of artists who design and sell products such as jewelry, cards, needlework; the women earn 70% of the revenue; the remainder returns to the business operation

k9 connection Empowering at-risk teenagers to build self-esteem and learn principles of positive reinforcement.

Program Impacts:

- Conducted 6 three-week courses in 3 schools and 1 residential treatment facility serving 128 high risk youth
- Facilitated the adoption of 22 dogs
- Made 110 youth outreach contacts
- 85 volunteers provided 1,587 hours of service

Services Include:

- 3-week after school program where youth ages 12-18 learn to train shelter dogs in basic obedience, enabling the dogs to become adoptable
- Teens are assisted in becoming responsible community members by focusing on goal-setting, accountability and motivation
- Through positive reinforcement, young people gain an awareness of the risks of uncontrolled, impulsive and violent behavior
- Graduates access peer leadership opportunities such as becoming future program volunteers

Program Impacts:

- Made 2,116 outreach contacts to homeless youth
- Provided a ‘lifeline’ of supportive services to 79 youth
- Moved 11 youth into temporary housing and 8 youth into permanent housing including family reunification

Services Include:

- Staff travels to places where runaway and homeless youth congregate to make contact and offer services
- Emergency assistance, counseling, case management and links to physical and mental health and substance abuse services
- Shelter placements or assistance with family reunification
- Education and outreach to reduce risk of sexual abuse and exploitation
- Weekly facilitated drop-in support groups

Safe Haven Empowering chronically homeless individuals living with addictions, mental illness and / or physical illness to rebuild their lives and end their homelessness through a unique, low barrier “housing first” program.

Program Impacts:

- Housed 35 individuals
- Placed 5 individuals in their own apartments
- Provided outreach and day services to 383 individuals
- Assisted 94 individuals in obtaining government income (SSI) through OPCC’s Project HOPE

Services Include:

- Immediate access to housing in a 25-bed shelter linked to supportive services
- High tolerance, low demand environment, with a focus on building trust leading to services for individuals with multiple diagnoses, many of whom have lived on the streets for many years
- Access to mental health, medical and drug and alcohol related services
- Case management, social and recreational services and benefits advocacy
- Goal: Placement in permanent housing

- Moved 288 individuals into transitional housing and 93 into permanent housing
- Helped 95 individuals to become employed

Services Include:

- Shelter for 110 adults with 3 meals daily
- On-site case management, medical care, counseling and mental health services, 12-step meetings, money management and legal assistance
- Assistance with locating housing and employment

- Provided restrooms, showers, laundry facilities and lockers to 281 participants
- Moved 71 individuals into housing

Services Include:

- Access to restroom and shower facilities
- Access to clothes washers and dryers
- Lockers for storage of belongings while looking for work and stable housing
- Engagement strategy to connect clients with case management and additional services to begin work to end their homelessness

- Provided a ‘lifeline’ of survival services to 2,812 battered women and their children
- Served 1,996 hotline callers
- Housed 59 women and 37 children in the Sojourn Crisis Shelter and 22 women and 30 children in Adams House
- Provided 24/7 emergency response services to 176 women and 49 children
- Provided court advocacy services to 586 women
- Conducted teen workshops for 329 youth
- Over 50 volunteers provided 2,918 hours of volunteer service

Services Include:

- Two safe, secure shelter facilities
- 24-hour hotline and 24-hour emergency response team
- Legal advocacy, including accompanying women to court appearances
- Children’s program, including clinical art/play therapy and empowerment play groups
- CalWORKS and GAIN Programs consisting of services for mothers receiving welfare; assists them in achieving financial self-sufficiency and stability
- School programs to educate teens and younger children about domestic violence

- Housed 139 individuals
- Moved 60 residents into permanent housing
- Engaged 60 former residents in the alumni program
- 1,007 volunteers provided 8,553 hours of service

Services Include:

- 55-bed shelter for homeless men and women with the goal of moving into permanent housing upon completion of the program
- Intensive case management, counseling and support groups
- Health education, job counseling and money management
- Independent living skills and computer classes
- Alumni program

Maryland Apartments and Permanent Supportive Housing

Empowering people to rebuild their lives by obtaining permanent, supportive housing is one of the solutions to homelessness. Through our scattered site Shelter + Care and Section 8 rental subsidy programs, individuals and families are able to afford safe, decent and permanent housing throughout Los Angeles County.

Section 8 provides subsidies to assist in paying the rent in permanent housing. Shelter + Care provides both rental subsidies and intensive case management and supportive services for people with disabilities so they can maintain their housing and live independently.



Over the next three years, OPCC intends to significantly expand its permanent supportive housing through adding additional scattered site apartments, as well as expanding our collaborations with affordable housing developers. Our goal is to double our number of permanent housing placements each year so that our clients can once again have homes of their own.

Program Impacts:

- Provided supportive services and housing to 29 residents of Maryland Apartments (93% of residents maintained their housing)
- Helped 265 individuals obtain permanent housing in scattered site apartments
- Enabled 120 individuals to retain permanent supportive housing with low tenant turnover

Services Include:

- Application assistance and screening of qualified tenants for rental housing
- Tenant education with a focus on timely payment of rent, good neighbor policy and proper care of apartment unit
- Landlord support services including landlord/tenant mediation
- Assistance with move-in costs
- Case management and apartment retention services

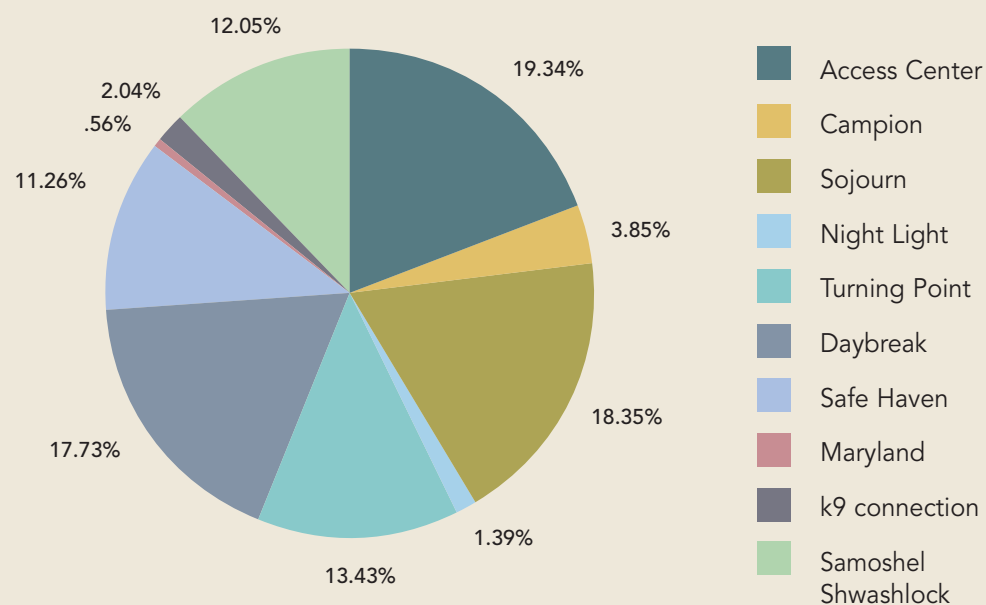
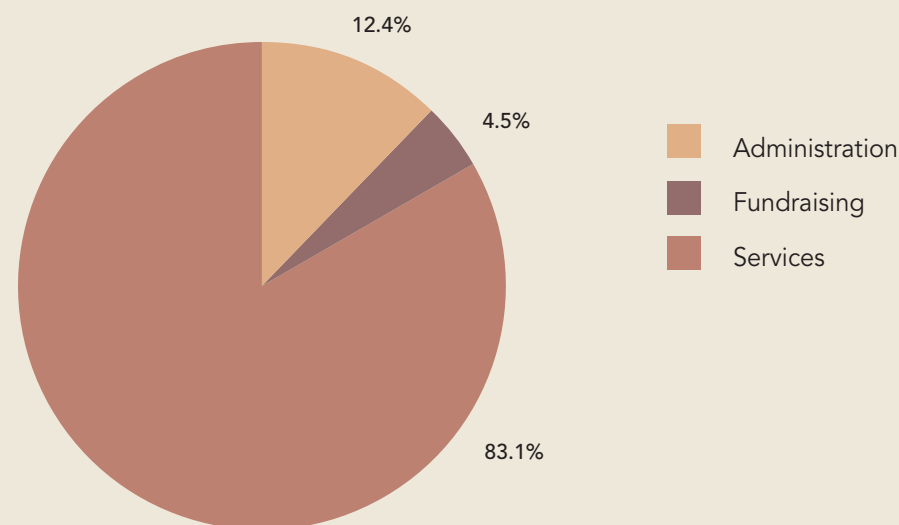

Isabelle

Freedom was always at the top of my pyramid of values. I thought this would be achieved through love; the exact opposite happened. I met my future husband, became pregnant quickly and, within a few months, began a marriage that for me was 17 years of psychological and emotional abuse that was covert and filled with anxiety, chaos, isolation and battles.

I began attending support groups, all offering something but none considered the root of the problem. I remained frustrated, reaching a greater depth of loneliness. The violence became progressively overt. I was the disciplinarian of three angry teenagers, alienated from them while their father provided opportunities for drugs and alcohol use, blaming consequences on me while suppressing me with abuse.

The idea of a shelter seemed dramatic as I was far from suspecting I was a battered wife. In 2004, however, it was a relief being there with no one screaming at me. Virulent attacks followed from which I had to defend myself, incurring legal debts that I still owe. Using the children, he carried

out his threat to “throw me in the street without a penny.” I regained full physical and legal custody of our three enraged teenagers. With no money or immediate ability to earn, I applied for government benefits. I had moved to Santa Monica and was directed to Sojourn.

Unlike all previous support groups, Sojourn offered me services and resources in a holistic approach. I was free from judgment and blame. I felt empowered making my own decisions, taking charge of my life and recovery. Sojourn has been a solid infrastructure quietly supporting my children, helping to put a stop to violence with this generation.

I’ve developed an awareness that is now protecting me from further violence. Sojourn staff nurtured me through advocacy, helping me pick up the pieces of my shattered family. Through the invaluable support I received from my Campion counselor, my business endeavors were encouraged. I am an empowered woman, anchored in my spirit and beliefs and a role model for my children.

Terry

Born and raised in Louisiana, Terry dropped out of school in 9th grade. Eventually he trained in carpentry, married, fathered a son and began his own business. Following a divorce, Terry moved to California in 1985 and got involved with selling drugs, becoming homeless and serving prison sentences. During his 2004-06 prison time, Terry realized that he could no longer continue this life of chaos and misery and upon release entered a 90-day drug rehab program. From there he came to Santa Monica where he lived in a sober living home and began a job search. Being “blind to reality” Terry fortunately landed at Turning Point, where “I thank God

every day for the staff and volunteers who have helped me to learn to distinguish right from wrong.”

Terry applied for a maintenance position at Steaven Jones Development Company and was hired in 2007. He drives a company van, takes two classes at Antioch College (with a volunteer tutor) and availed himself of all of the programs at Turning Point, “which gave me guidance, support, and made me feel like I was someone who could do right and think and live a good life.”

Terry shares with others who he hopes will start making the right choices that they “shouldn’t be afraid to change. It’s never too late and you’re never too old.”

FROM HOMELESSNESS TO HOPE: A Capital Campaign for OPCC

“The campaign raised \$3.5 million to help fund the operation of the expanded programs in both buildings and \$1 million towards a board-designated endowment fund.”

Through its \$19,500,000 capital campaign, OPCC continued to raise funds for its major expansion of services, including the construction of two new buildings, the OPCC Annenberg Access Center and the OPCC Cloverfield Services Center. The capital campaign, From Homelessness to Hope, concluded after the end of the fiscal year, in March 2008. The campaign co-chairs were Colette Brooks and Nigel Sinclair.

All of the campaign donors as of April 30, 2008 are listed on the following pages. In addition to providing funds for the construction and equipping of both buildings, the campaign raised \$3.5 million to help fund the operation of the expanded programs in both buildings and \$1 million towards a board-designated endowment fund.

The OPCC Cloverfield Services Center opened for services in January 2007. The Center contains Safe Haven, which expanded from a 10-bed nighttime-only program to a 25-bed program with full day services, and Daybreak Shelter, which expanded from 15 beds to 30 beds, with a greatly expanded space for Women In New Directions, Daybreak's daytime program for shelter residents, alumni and women waiting to enter the shelter.

Construction on the OPCC Annenberg Access Center began during the fiscal year, and was completed in September 2007. This facility more than doubles the space for the services of OPCC's SHWASHLOCK and Access Center programs, including showers, restrooms, washers and dryers, lockers, medical and mental health care, case management and services leading to housing and self-sufficiency.

GIVING TO OPCC

A majority of the gifts made to OPCC come in the form of cash via check or credit card. Below are some additional ways that you can give to support our programs.

Planned Charitable Gifts are designed for donors who want to make a significant and lasting contribution. These gifts may be made through bequests in a will or living trust, charitable gift annuities, charitable trusts, life insurance or life estates. In addition to benefiting OPCC, these gifts offer financial and tax advantages by reducing tax liability and increasing income for the donor and/or the donor's beneficiaries. Please contact your tax advisor to discuss the most effective ways to meet your personal and financial goals while supporting OPCC.

The following is a list of ways to include OPCC in your financial and estate plans:

Bequest: A gift given by a will or revocable living trust

Securities: A gift of stock, bonds or other similar assets

Life Insurance Policy: A gift of ownership in a policy

Real Estate: A gift of valued real estate

Charitable Gift Annuity: A contract with the California Community Foundation by which the Foundation pays a fixed income for one or two lives in exchange for a transferred asset. The Foundation transfers 95% of the remaining funds to OPCC's restricted fund upon the death of the beneficiaries. Rates of return are determined by the donor's age.

Charitable Remainder Trust: A trust that makes payments to one or more beneficiaries for life or a term of years not to exceed twenty. Later the trust dissolves and leaves the remainder to OPCC.

Charitable Lead Trust: A trust that make payments to OPCC during the donor's and/or the donor's loved one's lifetime. Later the trust dissolves and returns the assets to the donor or someone else designated by the donor.
